### 1 IDENTIFICATION OF THE SUBSTANCE/PREPARATION AND THE COMPANY

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### 2 COMPOSITION/INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

**COMPOSITION COMMENTS:** Based an aqueous acrylic polymer emulsion reinforced with calcareous filler

### 3 HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

This product is not classified as hazardous under current CHIP regulations

### 4 FIRST AID MEASURES

**INHALATION:** Move the exposed person to fresh air at once. Provide fresh air, warmth and rest, preferably in a comfortable upright sitting position. Get medical attention if any discomfort continues.

**INGESTION:** DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING! NEVER MAKE AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON VOMIT OR DRINK FLUIDS! Rinse mouth thoroughly. Promptly get affected personnel to drink large volumes of water to dilute the swallowed chemical. Obtain medical advice. Provide rest, warmth and fresh air.

**SKIN:** Remove affected person from source of contamination. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation develops
